Photography Policy

Ockbrook & Borrowash Cricket Club is keen to promote positive images of Young People playing Cricket and is not banning the use of photographic or video recording equipment.

However the Club must protect the interests of our Young People (anyone under 18)

The Executive Committee has agreed that the following procedures must be followed:

- 1. Photographs/images are not to be taken at matches or training without the prior permission of the parents/carers of the children. This permission is given or refused through the completion of the Application Form
- Only use images of children in appropriate kit (training or competition), to reduce the risk of inappropriate use, and to provide positive images of the children.
- 3. Images must not be sexual or exploitative in nature nor open to obvious misinterpretation or misuse.
- 4. Images must only be taken by authorised persons i.e. coaches/Parents/guardians/carers or authorised press.
- 5. All images must be securely stored.
- 6. If a Young Person(s) is named in a publication his/her photograph must not be used.
- 7. If a photograph is used the Young Person(s) name must not be used.
- 8. Team Manager/Captains will tell opposition when photographs cannot be taken.
- 9. The children should be informed that if they have concerns they can report these to the coach or team manager.
- 10. Concerns regarding inappropriate or intrusive photography should be reported to the Club Welfare Officer and recorded in the same manner as any other child protection concern.
